The TCHS Student Government invites all TCHS students and their guests to our Winter Ball, “The Snow Ball”, on January 13th, 2017! The event will be held in the Assembly Room of the school. Ticket prices are based on date purchased and whether or not you are a member of ASB. Ticket requests must be accompanied by payment (check made payable to “TCHS Student Government” or cash) **AND permission slip.** ***The last day to buy tickets is Wednesday, January 10th.***

Important Info

This is a high school event for students in grades 9 and above. If the guest is enrolled in high school, their school administrator’s approval is required in order to attend this event. If the individual is out of high school, he/she must have an interview with the TCHS administrative staff in order to attend, and must be no older than 20 years of age. The student of TCHS is accountable for their guest’s behavior and actions during the event.

Conduct

Students are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner that reflects the principles and values of our school, which are those honoring to Jesus Christ. Inability or unwillingness to comply will result in the immediate ineligibility of participating in the event.

Rules

- ✓ No use of illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages, or tobacco of any kind.
- ✓ No involvement of immoral behavior including inappropriate dancing
- ✓ Treat all students, staff members, and volunteers with respect
- ✓ Once you have left the activity you will not be able to re-enter
- ✓ TCHS chaperones have the right to refuse entry to any student or guest at the door (no refunds).
- ✓ No water bottles or beverage containers may be brought to the activity.

Students or guests who violate these guidelines will be asked to leave the event and parents will be contacted.

General Dress Code: Dressy/semi-formal

Ladies: Please dress modestly – we don’t want to have to give you a sweatshirt to wear over your beautiful dress! No plunging necklines, slits that go more than 3 inches above the knee, side cutouts or totally bare backs. Dresses may be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee, regardless of style.

Strapless dresses are allowed as long as no cleavage is exposed.

IF YOU ARE NOT SURE IF YOUR DRESS IS WITHIN THESE GUIDELINES, we highly suggest snapping a picture of your dress and running it by Mrs. Ryan at least a week before the dance.

Do NOT risk being sent home or asked to change, as we will do so if necessary.

Gentlemen - Collared shirts with a tie and slacks. No blue jeans or T-shirts. No sagging pants; please wear a belt if needed. If you are unsure if your outfit is in dress code, speak with Mrs. Ryan or Mr. Fitz.

Parents: please be aware that if your student arrives to the dance outside of these dress guidelines, they will be asked to return home and change before they enter the dance.

No exceptions. Please double check what your student is wearing before they leave for the dance.

Guest Policy - TCHS students may invite one guest and will be responsible for their guests at all times. Guests must be in high school and no older than 20 years of age.
