



PROPOSAL FOR “TRINITY CHRISTIAN HIGH SCHOOL PREP” – A 7-8 CLASSROOM PROGRAM

Introduction

Trinity Christian High School was founded to provide a high-quality, Christian education to the youth in Monterey Peninsula. TCHS has a sound educational program, rooted in God’s will and has recently been blessed with a site that will allow us to expand our student body. We believe we have been given the opportunity to transition into the inclusion of a middle school using a 7th/8th grade class model.

7/8 Transition Class Details

- The single 7/8 class will be led by a seasoned teacher who will teach the core subjects each day and serve as the administrator for the program.
- 7/8 day will stagger drop off and pick up times with high school. A limited Before and After Care program will be provided by the class teacher
- Chapel will be held in the Gym on Wednesdays following the High School Chapel
- Core curriculum will include: Language Arts (2 blocks), Math (1 block), Science (1 block), History (1 block)
- Subject teachers (some of who currently teach at the High School) will teach the following specialty classes:
 - PE 3 times per week
 - Bible
 - Elective Period – Spanish, The Arts, Yearbook
- Classroom computers will be available for student use at school.
- 7/8 Program will offer the following extra-curricular activities:
 - Afterschool sports / Junior Cheer
 - Archery/Paintball Clubs
 - Stand Up Paddle boarding
- 7/8 will exclusively use the downstairs (outside) bathrooms. (The high school students will use the upstairs bathrooms.)

A minimum of \$5,000.00 must be raised to support the middle school class during the 2017-18 school year. The class will take on a variety of projects to raise these funds.

To Apply:

- Complete the online application found under the “Admissions Tab” on our website www.trinityhigh.org and pay the \$75.00 enrollment fee no later than January 10, 2017
- Submit one recommendation form from a current teacher and one recommendation form from a counselor or an administrator.
- Submit a copy of your student’s most recent report card

To Enroll:

- When your student’s application has been accepted, you will receive an e-mail asking you to enroll. Follow the steps to complete your online enrollment form and pay the \$250.00 enrollment fee. Enrollment must be completed by February 28, 2017.

ADMISSIONS POLICY

Trinity Christian High School maintains a pattern of open admission, whereby all qualified students are accepted regardless of race, color, sex or ethnic origin. Admission of a student to TCHS Prep implies:

- A willingness to accept the philosophy, goals, and regulations which the school establishes.
- A personal desire to attend TCHS Prep
- A willingness to exhibit in one's personal actions and behavior the characteristics of a Christian individual.
- A family's willingness to support the efforts of the school by parental cooperation and involvement in academic, extracurricular, and school related activities
- A family's willingness to fulfill the financial obligations incurred in the student's education

Admission Requirements

In order to be considered for admission to Trinity Christian High School, the following steps must be completed.

1. Application. All students and their parents must complete the online application form and pay the application fee. Forms and instructions can be found on the "Admissions" tab at www.trinityhigh.org.
2. Letters of Recommendation. Recommendation forms can be downloaded from our website. We require one form to be completed by a current teacher.
3. Report card or transcripts. We require a copy of the student's most recent report card and/or a copy of the student's transcripts.
4. Immunizations. Once a student has been admitted to TCHS, an official immunization record is required to begin school (including evidence of the Tdap shot).

Admission Criteria

We look for students who will be successful in the Trinity Christian High School Prep Program –students who want to be here and parents who desire this type of education for their child. We seek first to be a Christian school, and teach every subject from a Biblical world-view perspective. All staff are professing Christians, and while it is not required for a student to be a Christian to be accepted to the TCHS Prep Program, it is required that the student and parents be open to hearing the gospel message. We seek students who are able to participate in our high school-preparatory classes to the fullest and are willing to do the work necessary to earn a grade of C or better in each course.

All applications that are received completed by 1-10-17 are eligible for the first tier of acceptances. An announcement of class size will be made at that time and acceptance and the wait list will be determined based on factors relating to the student's ability to be successful:
